
Sunday June 23rd Kid's Page: 3rd Sunday After Pentecost

Bible Stories: Mark 4:35-41

What we learn about God: Today Jesus and his disciples are out in a boat in the middle of a sea and a BIG storm hits. The winds are very, VERY strong and the disciples start to get scared. So, they wake Jesus up and he calms the storm. Jesus' reminded them that He is God with them and they should have some faith that He's got them.

As Jesus' disciples it's our job to model what Jesus does—and so we too are invited to help calm storms. BUT not the big storms outside—I don't think any of us are that powerful! What we can help with are the smaller storms inside of us—things like the bad feelings of fear, worry, sadness, etc. How can you show up to help others feel better when they forget to have faith?

Activity: Help get the boat safely through the storm—much like Jesus, you can help get the disciples—and others through the storms they feel inside them. Let's tell those waves to calm down!
