Bible Stories: Mark 5:21-43

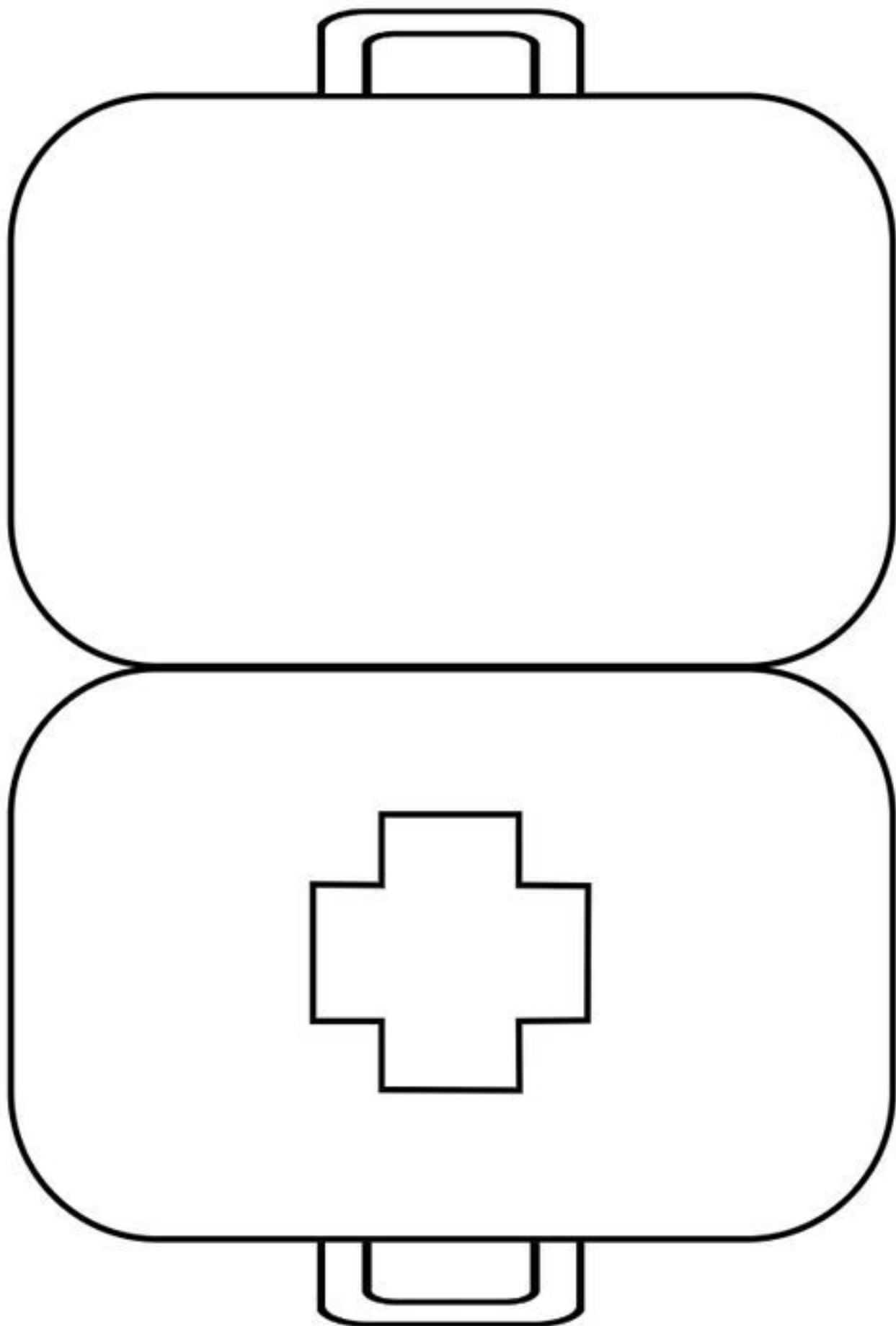
What we learn about God: Sometimes when we play TOO hard, we end up getting hurt. I can remember a time I was running with friends and got kicked in the face because I wasn't paying attention and I ran under the monkey bars! Not a good plan. Have you ever gotten hurt while playing?

In today's Bible story, Jesus heals two different people, with two very different hurts, in two very different ways.

It's a big deal to know and trust that God heals us and wants us to be well. God does this, because God loves us—no matter what.

When we are hurt we can turn to God for help too.

Activity: Design a band-aid and first aid kit. Think of different things that make you feel better when you feel bad in different ways—draw those in the kit. And make the band-aid something fun!
