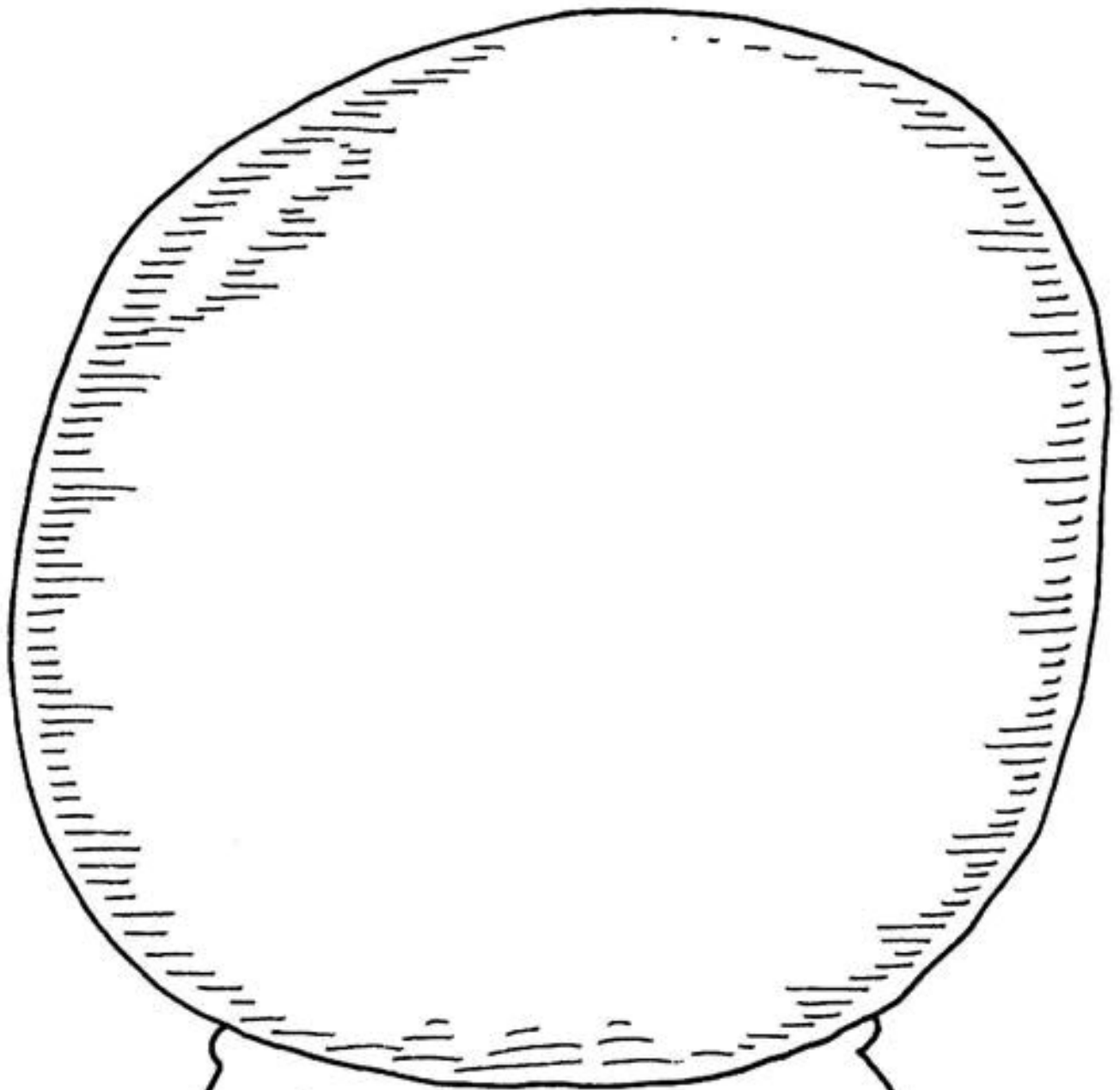


Sunday, July 28th Kid's Page: 10th Sunday After Pentecost

Bible Stories: Mark 6:30-34

What we learn about God: Today's Bible reading is filled with two of Jesus miracles. Do you know what a miracle is? A miracle is something really amazing that we weren't necessarily expecting. Sometimes that is something completely out of the ordinary—like Jesus walking on water. But other times it can be something more normal—like really hungry people being fed. Our lives are filled with miracles, which is pretty cool.
