Bible Stories: 1 Kings 19:4-8

What we learn about God: Today we get to hear a story from the life of a prophet, Elijah. Prophets were people who told others God's messages for him and the job was HARD work, because sometimes that meant delivering news that made people really unhappy. In the story today Elijah has a lot of BIG feelings. Big enough feelings that he wants to quit speaking for God. Then God reminds him that maybe with the BIG feelings of anger and sadness, he might also be feeling hungry and sleepy. After Elijah talks to God, eats some bread, and takes a nap, he feels much better and gets back to work for God. How cool is it that God knows exactly what we need when we feel bad? Just like Elijah we can always talk to God, get a snack, and rest.
