Bible Stories: John 6:56-69

What we learn about God: Today we get to hear more from Jesus about bread. Jesus has been talking about bread in church now for a whole month! Can you believe that? But the disciples aren't understanding what Jesus is saying. The disciples know what it is like to be hungry and worry about the bread they eat every day. But Jesus is trying to use a tricky language metaphor—saying that He, Jesus, is like bread in that Jesus gives us life, but Jesus is so much cooler than the bread we eat, because with Jesus we will live forever in heaven.

Activity: Sometimes it's hard to understand what heaven is like because we've never seen it and Jesus only tells us little bits and pieces. Take the pictures below that are partial pictures and create new pictures that show us something bigger. And remember—someday we will get to see all the wonder and glory of heaven and we will fully understand what Jesus as living bread means. But for today, we have to have faith that seeing what amazing things Jesus can do is just the beginning of the wonderful things God has in store for us.
