#### **A LITANY OF GIFTS**

#### **GREETING**

Church Council Moderator, Tori Everhart: Mt. Zion United Church of Christ, under the guidance of the Holy Spirit, has called the Reverend Amy Elizabeth Northridge as its senior pastor and teacher and respectfully requests that the York Association install her in this ministry among us, according to the faith and order of the United Church of Christ.

Association Representative, Rev. Eva O'Diam: The York Association of the Penn Central Conference of the United Church of Christ greets you in the name of Jesus Christ, the head of the church in heaven and on earth. The York Association has reviewed the request of Mt. Zion United Church of Christ. We have prayerfully examined Reverend Northridge, and we are pleased to install her as your senior pastor and teacher. Amy, servant of God, we invite you to come forward as a sign of your acceptance of the call to this office. #### **COVENANT**

Association Representative, Rev. Eva O'Diam: Dear friends, Mt. Zion United Church of Christ has declared, that having gathered under the guidance of the Holy Spirit, it has called Reverend Amy Elizabeth Northridge to minister in this place as settled pastor and teacher and that now receives her as appointed by God for this ministry. Association Members: We, the members of the York Association of the United Church of Christ, gather with you, the people and the pastor and teacher of Mt. Zion United Church of Christ, as a sign of our covenant and in celebration of our mutual ministry in Christ's name.

#### PRAYER OF INSTALLATION

Association Representative, Rev. Eva O'Diam: Let us pray. Almighty God, you have called your servants to make promises before you' now enable us to keep our vows that we may remain steadfast in faith and fruitful in every good work. Bless, we pray, your servant Amy Elizabeth Northridge, to whom the care of your people in this church is now committed. Pour out your Holy Spirit on her, on the people of Mt.
